

PAC Guidelines for Candidate Contributions

Whereas, the University of Missouri Flagship Council PAC was incorporated by the State of Missouri on October 21, 2005,

And whereas, the Corporation was organized primarily for, and at all times to benefit the Flagship Campus and the academic and educational programs of the University of Missouri at Columbia, Missouri, by supporting candidates for elected office at the state and local levels who are sympathetic to the goals and purposes of the Corporation,

And whereas, the Flagship Council PAC makes contributions, primarily during election years, to members of the General Assembly and candidates approved by the PAC Board of Directors;

Therefore, the PAC Board of Directors adopts the following guidelines regarding campaign contributions and other political activity:

The PAC Board of Directors shall support members of the General Assembly and statewide officeholders who are candidates for election who have demonstrated not only their support for higher education, but who understand and appreciate the value of our flagship institution to the State of Missouri; and,

The PAC Board of Directors will give priority consideration to the members of the University of Missouri Caucus who have supported our flagship institution; and,

The PAC Board of Directors may support candidates for election in open districts who are alumni or friends of our flagship institution; and

The membership list of the Flagship Council shall not be made available to any candidate or candidate committee (s).
